

Programme Course

- **Type:** Course with 10-15 hours training programme (2h preparation, 8-10h attendance, 2h Online-Module; optional follow-up: 5h mini-expedition with online mentoring)
- **Target groups:** Award leaders and coordinators, supervisors, expedition assessors (Bronze and Silver level), student mentors, independent participants at the gold level.
- **Aim:** The course provides the basic understanding of the Award philosophy, prepares for the design of the section Expeditions at Bronze and Silver level, introduces the most important mentoring tools and teaches the first steps of programme implementation and participation support. The practical outcome is a plan for one's own Award work.
- **Content:** The course is the official introduction to the programme and a prerequisite for being licensed and all further offers. The content is based on volume 1 of the Handbook. The method is "learning by doing": active learning forms sustainable learning and ensures that all participants can actively contribute. The work ends and begins at home: as preparatory homework, an initial overview of the handbook is developed, participation in an online module and the development of a personal Gold Programme are required - and in the follow-up, the plans developed are to be further discussed and a mini-expedition undertaken.
